

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PURPOSE:

The Department of Massachusetts Marine Corps League Scholarship Fund grants a limited number of Educational Scholarships to qualified individuals who are pursuing full time undergraduate studies or technical training at a recognized institution in order of need and preference as follows:

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. U.S. Marine, FMF Navy Corpsman or Navy Chaplain who lost their lives in the line of duty. Their widows, children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, stepsons/stepdaughters or siblings.
- 2. A member in good standing who has attended 3 detachment meetings and is eligible to vote at the Department Convention in the year in which the application is made.
- 3. Widows, children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, stepsons/stepdaughters or siblings of a members in good standing of the Department of Massachusetts,

Massachusetts Marine Corps League Detachment or Marine Corps League Auxiliary member.

REQUIREMENTS OF OBTAINING A SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. New Applicant.
 - a. Any applicant who has not previously applied or been awarded a Department of Massachusetts scholarship.
- 2. New applicants must complete the scholarship application form and ensure that all of the required supporting documentation are enclosed with the application in a single package.
- 3. Documentation should be assembled as stated below and must include:
- 4. A letter from a representative from the applicant's high school and/or college stating the applicant's ability and the school's recommendation as to further education.
- 5. Applicant must complete the application form and provide a copy of the grades with a minimum of B average from the college or university attended during the previous year.
- 6. A letter from the applicant (not more than three pages) with a brief life history and the reason for seeking the scholarship. To include high school or college honors, school, community, church other extracurricular activities.
- 7. Letters of recommendation Two (2) single pages from persons other than the applicant's family who have known the applicant for three years or more.
- 8. Institution's acceptance Proof of an educational of the applicant.

REQUIREMENTS OF OBTAINING RENEWAL SCHOLARSHIP:

1. Renewal Applicant. Having been previously awarded a Department of Massachusetts, Marine Corps League Scholarship.

- 2. Applicant must complete the application form and provide a copy of the grades with a minimum of B average from the college or university attended during the previous year.
- 3. Letter from applicant stating their progress and goals for this upcoming semester

SUBMISSION DEADLINE and AWARD:

- All applications for scholarships must be submitted to the Chairman of the Department of Massachusetts Scholarship Committee on or before May 1st of each year being applied for.
- 2. Scholarship to be announced at state convention the first weekend in June.
 - **a.** Award to be given to first year application upon receipt of a paid or unpaid bill for the institution attending
 - **b.** Award to be given to renewal application at the state convention. Attendance not required

SCHOLARSHIP IN GENERAL
